

## 2015-2016 Library and Learning Resources Committee Report

The Library and Learning Resources Committee met twice this academic year. On September 28, 2015, the committee met to discuss the library's budget situation and the proposed cuts to current subscriptions, amounting to approximately \$55,000 for the current year. These proposals were then sent to the faculty for feedback. After also presenting this information at the October 15 faculty senate meeting, the provost helped to alleviate some of the cuts with additional funding.

The committee met again on April 19, 2016, principally to hear about the library remodel design proposals submitted by architectural firm Arcturis. Funding has not yet been secured for implementing the renovation.
