The Conflict of Interest committee reviewed 14 potential conflict of interest disclosures from July 2016 to July 2017. The review result letters for each disclosure are filed in the Office of Finance and Operations, which is the location for the official public record.

Disclosures are generally processed by the committee using email, which provides the fastest way for gathering responses and consolidating findings. The COI committee review, assessment, and results letter are generally completed within a week from the time the committee chairman receives the fully signed disclosure form. Some disclosures take longer to process due to the complexity of the situation that must be addressed.

Randy Stoll's retirement required his permanent position to be filled. Randy's replacement is Anas Massri, Assistant Vice Chancellor of Finance. The committee currently has a vacancy for a Faculty Senate appointment.
