3. IT Updates:

- Policy changes- all policies were renumbered and several new went live vesterday.
- Cell phone policy was among those policies that went live yesterday.
 - A final draft was not sent out and no notice was given to Dan prior to this policy going live.
 - Cell phones provided by the university will be significantly limited. New policy lists categories of approved people but a review will be implemented. Each person who has a university funded cell phone will be interviewed to determine need.
 - New policy includes a personal use clause
- Secure Auth goes live on 12/19
- Power outage on 12/20
 - Expecting no interruptions to the data centers.
 - Will have networking in all buildings that still have power.
 - o No networking/wifi in those buildings that will not have power.
- Pantheon
 - Cost is a deterrent in going forward with replacement of terminal four.
 Willing to look into other options.
 - Will work with student council regarding WordPress sites.
- Software/download policy
 - o Revisit in January meeting.
 - Need to generate a document with software download exceptions.
- UM Administrator review has gone public
- System wide work survey for staff will be coming out soon. Looking for duplicity.
- Simplify the active directory
 - Will not affect the domain

- o Will save maybe 1 million dollars in hardware and resources
- ITSM- Remedy is going to be replaced. Looked at 4 products, 2 were eliminated.
- Ethics Compliance Hotline and Case Management- put the project charter in the Google drive
- DoIT- Putting in a plan for moving to the cloud, reducing administrative footprint in data centers
- IT RSS recently became involved in FFA Drone Regulation Program- would reduce regulations.
