When requesting instrumentation support, the following questions will be addressed:

- 1) Is the driving computer Win 10?
- 2) If not Win 10, can the system be upgraded to Win 10?
- 3) If not upgradable to win 10, can the computer be replaced with one that can run win 10?
- 4) If a computer upgrade is not possible,
- 5) Is the instrument being used for funded research?
- 6) If the instrument is being used for funded research, is this capacity available elsewhere on campus?
- 7) If the instrument is being used for funded research and the capacity is NOT available elsewhere on campus, IT will join the faculty member with a request for upgrading the instrument with funding from other sources.
